<p>Task 1 - Shape Hunt</p>	<p>Look around your home and find 2D shapes. Can you name the shapes you find?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Circle – coin, plate, toy wheel • Square – tile, book, board-game square • Rectangle – window, door, toy brick • Triangle – pizza slice, magnetic shape • Pentagon – football panel, toy badge • Hexagon – bolt head, coin, construction toy piece <p><u>Extra Challenge</u> Can you sort your shapes into groups? Which shape was the easiest to find? Which shape was the hardest to find?</p>
<p>Task 2 - My Home</p>	<p>Talk to someone at home about your home. What rooms do you have? Which room is your favourite? Why?</p> <p>My Home – Draw Draw a picture of your home. Can you add a door and some windows?</p> <p>My Home – Label Try to label your picture with words like: <i>door, window, roof, room, bed.</i></p> <p><u>Extra Challenge</u> Can you write a simple sentence to explain what each room is for? For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>The kitchen is for cooking.</i> • <i>The bedroom is for sleeping</i>
