Homework/Reading

This term, we will be focusing on reading within the classroom through both guided reading and reciprocal reading sessions. Home reading books will be sent home every **Monday** and should be returned to school each **Thursday**. Pupils will continue to have their own 'Reading for Pleasure' book available to them in school.

Please aim to read with your child as often as possible, as regular reading at home plays a vital role in supporting their progress and confidence.

Inquiry

This term, our class will be exploring the inquiry question: "What makes places around the World special and unique?". We will focus on physical features of the landscapes, climate, plants, animals and how people live in Wales and very different parts of the World such as rainforests. We will investigate real-life examples, consider how people respond to these changes, and compare our experiences with those in other parts of the world. We will learn to compare places and recognise why they are important, whilst exploring how climate and landscape can influence daily life.
