New letter sounds and flash cards will be added as and when your child is ready for new ones to practice. Please comment in their reading journals to let us know how they are getting on. Send your child's reading book and journal to school every day so that they can also read with us during the week.

Topic

Interdependence – How does the natural world work and connect?' is our new inquiry question where the children will explore living things in the world around them. We will investigate our school and local area, looking at how people, plants and animals grow and change, exploring habitats, and understanding how seasons change over time.
